



# Who does Montenegro choose?

- gender, age, the geographic and professional structure of electoral lists in early 2023 Parliamentary elections -

Podgorica, 2023

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# Introduction

Early parliamentary elections will be held on 11 June 2023. Total of 15 electoral lists are participating, with a total of 1113 candidates1 who will compete for 81 parliamentary seat.

The main objective of this research is to provide a cross-section of those electoral lists in terms of gender, age, and regional and professional structure of the candidates so that citizens and the interested public have a deeper cross-section of the electoral offer in that aspect.

The data has been processed in a manner that does not reveal personal data about candidates for MPs and provides all the relevant information set by the research task.



# General analysis of electoral lists

# **Gender structure**

Regarding gender representation, all the lists have fulfilled the legal requirement of having at least 30% of candidates from the underrepresented gender, as well as the positioning of at least one candidate from the underrepresented gender among every four candidates2, noting that without meeting these criteria, the lists would not have been ultimately confirmed by the State Election Commission (SEC).

Out of a total of 1113 candidates, there are 715 (64%) men and 398 (36%) women on the lists. These data indicate a slight improvement in achieving a better gender balance, although there is still room for improvement in achieving gender equality within party structures and, consequently, effective political participation of women. Only one out of the 15 confirmed electoral lists is led by a woman. It is the civic list "YES. WE CAN FOR CIVIC MONTENEGRO", where the percentage of women representation is significantly above the average at 58%. Besides this list, two lists representing national minority parties – the Bosniak Party (BP) and the Croatian Civic Initiative (CCI) – also have a notable percentage of women at 41% each, along with the coalition gathered around the Democratic Party of Socialists (DPS) with 40% however, on most other lists, the percentage of women representation remains within the limits of the legal minimum or below, as mentioned above.


# Age structure

The age structure of the candidates is very heterogeneous, with the youngest candidate being 18 and the oldest 82<sup>3</sup>. When all 15 confirmed lists are taken, i.e. all 1113 candidates, the average age of those who want to represent citizens in the next convocation of the Parliament is 41 years.

The youngest list is JUSTICE FOR ALL! - Dr VLADIMIR LEPOSAVIĆ with the average age of the candidates 33 years, while the oldest list is the CCI on which the candidates are 51 years old on average.




Graph: age structure

# **Regional structure**

Analyzing the candidates' place of residence, a significant disparity in the distribution of candidates across different municipalities is observed.

The highest concentration of candidates is from the capital city of Podgorica, with 266 candidates, i.e. 23.9% of the total number. It is followed by Nikšić with 81 candidates (7.28%), Tuzi with 76 candidates (6.83%), and Ulcinj with 72 candidates (6.47%). On the other hand, municipalities such as Šavnik, Andrijevica, Petnjica, and Plužine have the lowest number of candidates, ranging from only 5 to 6 candidates (0.45% - 0.54%).




None of the lists included citizens from all 25 municipalities in Montenegro. The most comprehensive in this regard is the list led by the coalition around DPS, whose candidates come from 24 municipalities. Following that is the coalition of Democrats and URA, which covers candidates from 23 municipalities, and the coalition of Socialist People's Party (SNP) and DEMOS, with candidates from 21 municipalities. On the other hand, there are three minority lists – Albanian Alternative, whose candidates come from three municipalities, the HGI list, which covers candidates from six municipalities, and the Albanian Forum list, which has candidates from six municipalities.

# **Profesional structure**

The candidates are characterized by a diversity of professions, which can contribute to a variety of ideas and perspectives brought into the political arena. For this research, occupations have been grouped into the following sectors:

- **1.** Law (Ph.D. in legal sciences, lawyers, specialists in legal sciences, graduated lawyers, legal technicians);
- 2. Political Science and Social Work (Ph.D. in Political Science, Master's in Political Science, Bachelor's in Political Science, Bachelor's in Social Work);
- **3. Education and Science** (Ph.D. in science, professors, teachers, educators, historians, biologists, mathematicians, chemists, archaeologists, philosophers, philologists, forensic experts);
- **4. Healthcare** (doctors, specialists and subspecialists, dentists, veterinarians, psychologists, pedagogues, cosmetologists, medical technicians);
- **5. Economics and Management** (masters of economic sciences, graduate economists, auditors, bankers, accountants, human resource managers, marketing specialists, business management, economics technicians);
- 6. Technology and Engineering (engineers of mechanical engineering, metallurgy, mining, agronomy, agriculture, forestry, environmental protection, sanitary engineers, electrical engineers, computer scientists, programmers, electronics, electrical technicians, technicians);
- **7. Construction and Architecture** (architectural engineers, construction engineers, surveyors, construction technicians);
- 8. Tourism, Maritime, and Transportation (graduate tourismologists, tourism representatives, tourism workers, restaurateurs, hoteliers, maritime managers, sailors, captains, pilots);
- **9.** Art, culture, media, and sport (visual artists, visual artists, cultural experts, conservators, directors, video editors, graphic designers, journalists, and athletes);
- **10. Economy** (entrepreneurs, business owners, traders, workers in the economy, sales representatives, farmers, craftsmen, businessmen)
- 11. Students and pupils
- **12. Retirees**
- **13. Unclassified** (insurance agents, housewives, correspondents, foreign correspondents, drivers, graduates in criminology, officers, customs technicians, civil servants, public administration, experts of American diplomacy, executive secretaries, security managers)




The largest number of candidates is from the field of economy and management (223), followed by education and science (154) and law (149).

For easier classification of occupations, it is recommended to include guidelines in the Instructions for the Content and Format of Forms for Proposing Candidates for the Election of Councilors and MPs. Additionally, Form PG-2 (Declaration of Acceptance of Candidacy) could be improved by adding fields to collect data on the level of educational qualification of candidates, thus providing more detailed information about the education and expertise of candidates

# Detailed cross-section by electoral

### 1. It is clear! – Bosniak Party – mr Ervin Ibrahimović

The Bosniak Party has 48 men (59%) and 33 women (41%) among 81 candidates.




Regarding the age structure, the average is 37 years.



# 2. CCI – On the right side of the world




On average, the candidates on this list are 51 years old.


The dominant number of candidates is from Tivat.

This list has 55 candidates, of which 38 are men (69%) and 17 are women (31%).




Graph: gender structure


Most of the candidates on this list are from Podgorica.

The SPP-DEMOS coalition has a total of 81 candidates, 55 men (68%) and 26 women (32%).




Relating to the geographical distribution of candidates, the list is scattered, with a slightly larger number of those from Podgorica.

#### 5. "THE PEOPLES COALITION – UNITED AND PERIOD" – (Dejan Vukšić – Demochristian movement; Marko Milačić – Real Montenegro; Vladislav Dajković – Free Montenegro; Dragica Perović – the Democratic Serbian Party; dr Novica Stanić – Movement for Pljevlja)

This coalition has a total of 81 candidates, of which 56 are men (69%) and 25 are women (31%).




Graph: gender structure


Most of the candidates on this list are from Podgorica.

The Albanian Alliance has 67 candidates, including 46 men (69%) and 21 women (31%).




The average age of the candidates on this list is 37 years.


Most of the candidates are from Ulcinj.

The Turnover list has 54 candidates, of which 37 are men (69%) and 17 are women (31%).






Most of the candidates on the list are from Podgorica.

The Movement for Change has 81 candidates, including 51 men (63%) and 30 women (37%).




Graph: gender structure


The list has the most candidates from Podgorica.

# 9. YES. WE CAN FOR CIVIC MONTENEGRO!

This list has 77 candidates, including 32 men (42%) and 45 women (58%), making it the only list where women are in the majority.




Graph: gender structure


The largest number of candidates is from Podgorica.

The list has 81 candidates of which 49 are men (60%) and 32 are women (40%).


Although the list covers a wide range of Montenegrin municipalities, the majority of candidates are from Podgorica.

The Europe Now list has 81 candidates, among whom there are 53 men (65%) and 28 women (35%).




The largest number of candidates on this list is from Podgorica.

The electoral list of the SDP has 81 candidates, of which 55 are men (68%) and 26 are women (32%).




Although there are candidates from a large number of municipalities, the majority of them are from Podgorica.

The list has 81 candidates, of which 56 are men (69%) and 25 are women (31%).



This list has candidates from almost all municipalities, but the largest number is from Podgorica.




Grafik: regional structure

The list has 81 candidates, out of which 55 are male (68%) and 26 are female (32%).




Despite the participation of candidates from different municipalities, the largest number is from Podgorica.

This list has 60 candidates, of which 42 are men (70%) and 18 are women (30%).




